

Holiday Ornament featuring Clarence Town Park Clubhouse Centennial

The fourth ornament sponsored by the Clarence Hollow Association is on sale now. It depicts the Clarence Town Park Clubhouse which will be celebrating its centennial year in 2011 with several planned events. In 1910 the Automobile Club of Buffalo (ACB), now AAA Western and Central New York acquired the 69-acre site on the west hill in Clarence Hollow. The following year the new "Country Home" of the ACB opened and was a popular gathering place for members. In 1957 the Town of Clarence purchased the building and surrounding property from the ACB. The Clarence Hollow Association is proud to offer this ornament in recognition of the centennial celebration. The white ornament depicts the Clubhouse, the Automobile Club's logo, AAA charm attached and legend written on the box. It is a beautiful custom commemorative ornament and will be an addition to your home or to purchase as a gift for someone.
